

Each player begins each match with the initial buyin of chips • No rebuy or add-on • Both players draw a card, high card is the first dealer • The dealer is the small blind and acts first pre-flop and last post-flop • Each player deals after offering a cut to the non-dealing player who shall be dealt the first card • Blinds are frozen at the last level • Showing cards is allowed in heads-up play • An absent player's chips shall be blinded off at the rate of one hand every 3 minutes for the first 15 minutes and every 90 seconds thereafter • To hold a 32 or 64 player tournament, simply add names to 1 or 3 more sheets and hold an additional playoff with each sheet winner • Visit www.homepokertourney.com for more rules and info
